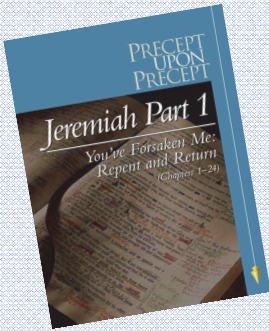

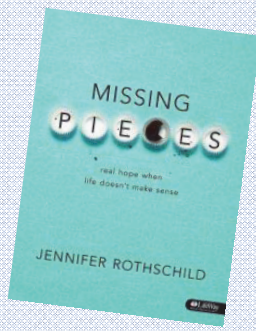

New Bible Study Groups Begin Thursday, January 10



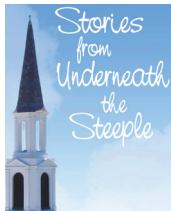
The Precept Bible Study groups will


