Don't forget that you have one more opportunity to review a proposed vision of our Planning Committee. The first meeting was Wednesday, June 19th. The second meeting will be this afternoon, at 5:00 p.m. This meeting will be in Assembly Room #1 located on the second floor of the Main Building.

This Wednesday, June 26, we will have a special called Business Meeting for the purposes of adopting a motion put forward by the Planning Committee that will allow us to move forward with developing plans to build a new addition containing a Fellowship Hall and Adult Education space.

The motion will be as follows:

The Planning Committee recommends adopting the Phase 2 proposal, presented by MG&A of Birmingham, Alabama, a Development, Design, and Construction Company, which is described as approximately a 28,000-square-foot addition containing a 500 seat Fellowship Hall with accompanying 18 adult classrooms, restrooms and commons space. We also recommend engaging the services of MG&A for the purpose of designing and constructing Phase #2 of their proposed Master Plan. Phase #2 will be built for a Guaranteed Maximum Price (which the church will approve) to be established once the construction documents are completed. Further, the Planning Committee recommends entering into a three-year Capital Campaign to begin in the Fall of *2013.*
