Pastor Elected LBC President
First Baptist Lafayette
Pastor Steve Horn was elected President of the Louisiana Baptist Convention last week. Messengers voted unanimously at the two-day annual meeting in Alexandria, Louisiana.

In nominating Dr. Horn, Phil Robertson of Deville, Louisiana, said Steve was "a humble, committed servant of God," and a soul winner who preaches the gospel." He noted that 450 people have been baptized since Steve became pastor of First Baptist Lafayette, and that he was committed to the Southern Baptist Co-operative Program as "the most effective method of reaching the world."

We congratulate Steve on his election, and will be praying for him as he leads our state convention in the year ahead.


