country.

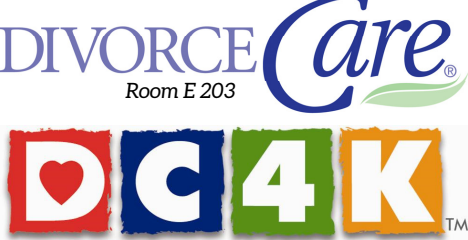
Dennis Swanberg takes more than twenty

I am humbled and grateful for God’s provision and your willingness to attempt great things for God. Praise the LORD!
