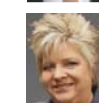

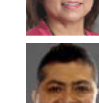

**Do Something Update:** Last Sunday night, I reported the top six ideas as "voted on" in our Focus Group Meetings.

For the benefit of those who were not able to be with us Sunday, here are the top six items.

- Adopt UL in a greater way than present
- Expand First Baptist Christian School to a High School
- Hold a Traditional Revival Service
- Take Leadership in Hosting an Area-wide Crusade
- Establish a Staff Position Dedicated to Organizing Benevolence or Compassion Ministries
- Establish a Satellite Campus or Second Location of First Baptist Church

As reported on Sunday evening, I have appointed six of our staff members to head up Task Forces on each of the six ministry initiatives. They will report back to the church on November 2 in our evening worship. Please be in prayer for these teams.

Lastly, if you are interested in being a member of First Baptist Church, I strongly urge you to come to the **First Look** seminar today. This will be the last seminar of this kind for 2014. In this two-hour seminar, we consider the history and beliefs of Baptists and consider what it means to be a member of First Baptist Church. We will meet from 5:30 until 7:30.
