Scripture Meditation for Silent Reading during the Distribution of the Bread 1 Corinthians 11:17-24

¹⁷ Now in giving the following instruction I do not praise you, since you come together not for the better but for the worse. ¹⁸ For, to begin with, I hear that when you come together as a church there are divisions among you, and in part I believe it. ¹⁹ There must, indeed, be factions among you, so that the approved among you may be recognized.²⁰ Therefore when you come together in one place, it is not really to eat the Lord's Supper.²¹ For in eating, each one takes his own supper ahead of others, and one person is hungry while another is drunk!²² Don't you have houses to eat and drink in? Or do you look down on the church of God and embarrass those who have nothing? What should I say to you? Should I praise you? I do not praise you for this!

²³ For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: on the night when He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took bread, ²⁴ gave thanks, broke it, and said, "This is My body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."
