Welcome to First Baptist

Church. If you are our guest, thank you for joining us today. We would love to be able to get to know you. Take a moment to register as a guest using the registration card attached to the bulletin. This morning, we are continuing a series called. "Ascend." This series is an expositional study of Psalms 120-134. Each of these Psalms has the heading "Song of Ascents." Most believe these are songs worshippers sung as they made their way to Jerusalem for thrice annual special times of worship. Kelvin has been in the news in recent years for his Christian faith and Biblical views on marriage which led to his dismissal as the Fire Chief of Atlanta, Georgia.
