Sermon Notes

Easter! So What? What Should I Do Then With Jesus? Matthew 27:1-2, 11-26

Pilate’s question, “What should I do then with Jesus who is called the Christ” (v. 22) is the same question that each of us faces. Pilate made the wrong choice. The reasons that caused Pilate to make the wrong choice are the same factors that cause many to reject Christ today.

What are those factors?

- by what other people think.

Pilate’s Position

- As Governor, he was trained to
- As Judge, he was trained to

Pilate’s Problem:

- of who Jesus is.
- in temporary favor at the expense of eternal favor.
- to make a choice.

So What?

You will find that it is to not make a decision about Jesus.

You will discover that the decision you make about Christ all other decisions.
