As a Christian, every day ought to be a celebration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The resurrection of Jesus is the key to everything else that we believe. The apostle Paul gave us a glimpse of what life would be like if Christ had not been resurrected when he wrote:



"And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty. And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins! Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable."

But, then, Paul answered his own rhetoric with this exclamation:

"But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep." (1 Corinthians 15:14, 17-20)

We have gathered today to celebrate what we ought to celebrate every day as Christians: Christ is risen! If you are a guest today, we are glad you are here.
